- 1. Call to Order and Roll Call
- 2. **Agenda Modifications** No modifications to the agenda were requested.

- 5. **Acceptance of previous meeting Minutes -** The Oct 6th Meeting Minutes were recognized and accepted by a roll call vote.
- 6. Implementation Activity and Work Group Reports
 - a. Election of Chair and Vice Chair Following discussion of the need to elect a Chair and reviewing the roles and responsibilities stated in the Poso Creek IRWM MOU, Dana Munn was nominated as Chair and Ram Venkatesan as Vice Chair of the Poso Creek RWMG. A motion was made followed by roll call vote that was unanimous in favor of electing Dana Munn as the new Chair and Ram Venkatesan as the Vice Chair.
 - b. Governance MOU Adjustments Following discussion, the RWMG recognized that each RWMG member had signed the 1st Amendment to the MOU at the time of the Poso Creek IRWM Plan Update. Possible need for future adjustments based on entities joining the Plan was discussed.
 - c. Request for participation from SSJMUD Following discussion, the RWMG recommended a Workshop be scheduled to further evaluation the equity of participation by new entities to the RWMG.
 - d. Request for participation from Matt Hurley Following discussion, no decision or actions were taken by the RWMG.
 - e. 2016 Budget for IRWM Activities Following discussion, a 2016 operating budget was tentatively approved, however, a vote to approve the budget was tabled until a Workshop could be held with the RWMG on February 2nd.
 - f. Calloway Canal Lining North Kern and Cawelo The lining of the canal is complete and ready for operations. NK provided a summary of remaining activity which is basically filing the grant completion reports for the one State and five federal grants received for this activity.
 - g. Madera Ave Intertie Modification Kimberlina Recharge Facility Dana Munn provided a summary of progress on the modified project. Shafter-Wasco ID continues to work with Reclamation and consultants towards a new grant contract and to complete the NEPA document for the project.



- h. IRWM Rnd3 Imp Funding North Kern and LHUD Rnd3 IRWM grant funding awards were expected to be finalized later in the week.
- i. IRWM Eligibility AWMP December, 2015 requirement Several of the Poso Creek IRWM agricultural districts reported on their processing of their AWMPs with DWR.
- j. Irrigated Lands program Dave Hampton, Cawelo Water District provided a brief overview of program activity.
- k. GW SGMA activity Eric Quinley, DEID, provided an update of SGMA activity west of DEID and Dana Munn provided an update of the Kern activity.
- 1. K-TWD SGMA purposed boundary adjustment Skye Grass, K-TWD, requested to table this item until a future meeting.
